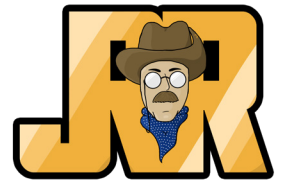

A “SWEET” STORY FROM THE FIRST FAMILY OF MEDORA

My dad, Harold Schafer, started taking me to Medora when I was six years old. Thirteen years later, in 1965, he opened the town’s first venue, the Rough Riders Hotel. The hotel had 11 rooms, a restaurant, and a couple of small meeting rooms — and still today, it’s the center point of activities in Medora. (You can do the math and find out how old I am now! Hint: my hair is really, really gray!)

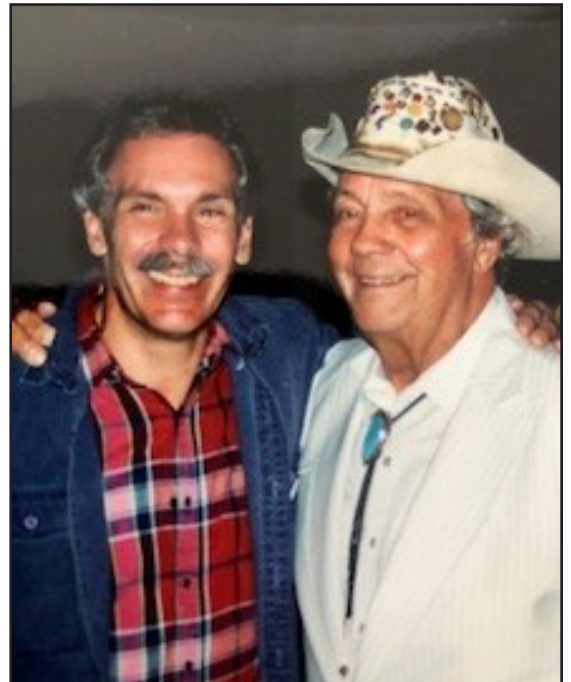
It is my privilege to serve as the Chair of the Board of Directors of the Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation, and when I think about how much Medora has grown and improved since those first days, I think about **ice cream!** You see, my dad loved ice cream. We used to tease him that he only bought cars that automatically stopped at Dairy Queen stores.

One of my jobs that first summer was hand-cranking ice cream for visitors. My father wanted travelers to enjoy a cold, sweet treat while they strolled down the streets of the dusty old town of Medora. Of course, even though it was his idea, *I* was the one who had to make the ice cream!

Way back then, you couldn’t buy ice cream anywhere in town. So we had a couple of small containers that were set in ice and rock salt. We sat along the dirt street in front of the hotel and turned a crank that rotated paddles and swirled the liquid mixture until it froze. Then we had ice cream! Oh, I forgot to mention: it was often very hot, so we had to be careful not to drop sweat on the goodies.

Today, ice cream is offered in 10 places around town, and people are still enjoying cold treats while they wander around Medora as my father wanted them to do so many years ago.

Here's how it works:

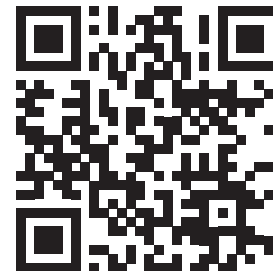
- If your youngster would like to participate, please email Colleen that Junior Rough Rider's name, at colleenr@medora.com. This email functions as a "permission slip."

We hope you would let each other know when you are visiting Medora. We suggest meeting up with Joe Wiegand for a trek on the new Pancratz Trails located right in town!

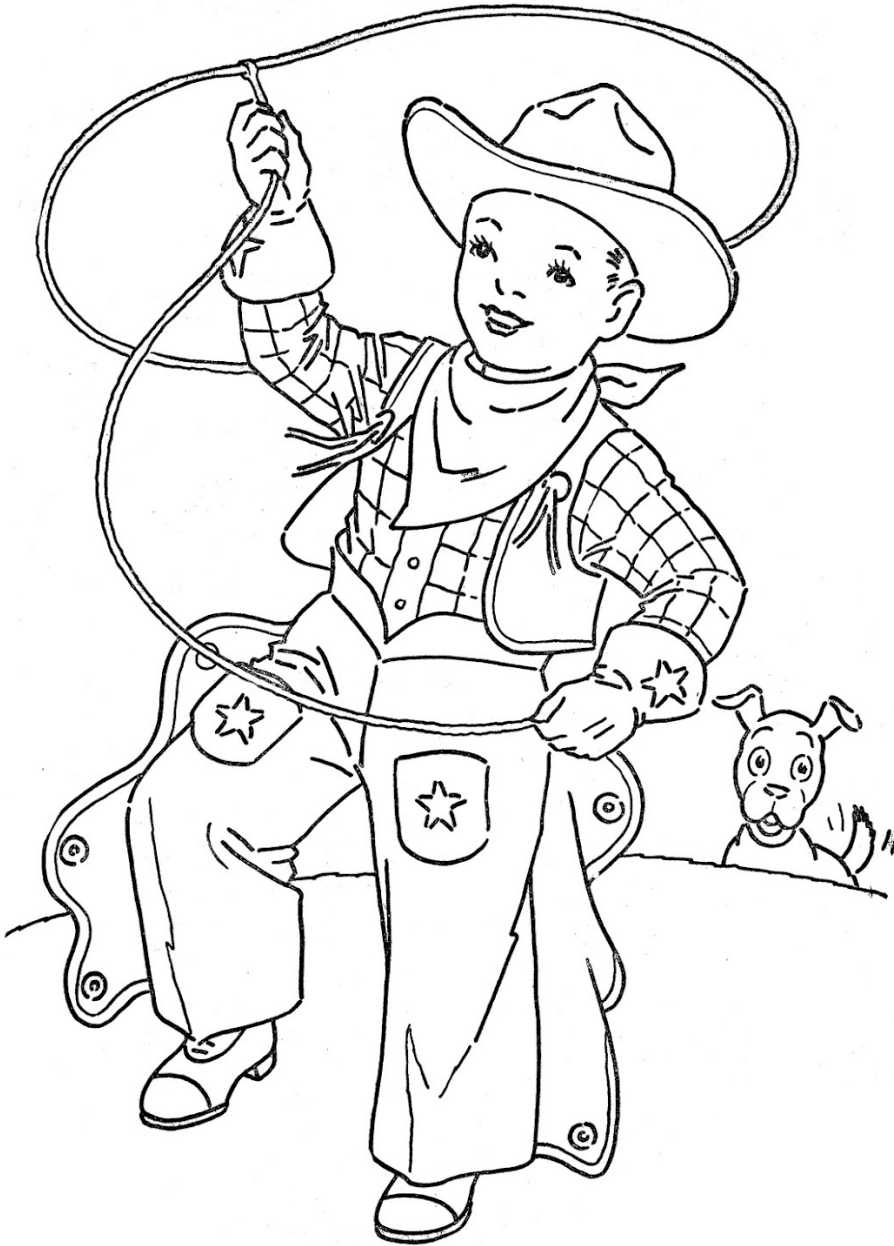
