

OUTGOING BOARD CHAIR

Dear friends of Medora:

This spring, my wife Becky and I had the opportunity to celebrate our 51st wedding anniversary in Medora.

The "off season" of solitude in what typically is our sleepy old western community is changing, as new Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation (TRMF) entertainment opportunities occur monthly, breathing a new energy and activity to life.

In this case, the Old Town Hall Theater was rocking with five sold out performances of "Cash versus King." The Rough Riders Hotel was full, Theodore's jammed, and the streets of Medora were full of visitors ready to have some fun.

Of course, all of this is simply a precursor to the activity to come in 2026, when the Theodore Roosevelt Presidential Library (TRPL) opens. We had an opportunity to tour the construction site, as the project is a little over a third complete, and on schedule.

It's simply breathtaking! While the inside of the Library will have a "WOW" around every corner, the panoramic views of the Badlands in virtually every direction are beyond magnificent. The planning of TRPL is incredibly detailed, and the team involved are doing a great job.

One heartwarming thing we noticed in visiting the site was the immense pride projected by everyone involved, in regard to the opportunity to be a part of this special project. Virtually everyone working on site are North Dakotans, from the construction management company, to all the subcontractors, engineers, etc. They know TRPL is historic, a source of pride for everyone in our State.

And, TRPL is another example of the impact of philanthropy. Those of you who know me recognize I often speak to the philanthropic culture of our country, as distinct globally, and what separates the U.S. from the rest of the world. The imbedded "requirement" within our society to give back, is so important to our communities.

This was especially evident at the TRMF last year, where donors invested a record \$8.8 million into various projects, endowments, and general support of the various activities we sponsor. Most important, this continues a trend over the last five years, critical to both the present and future of TRMF/Medora.

Never has there been a more exciting time at TRMF! TRMF Management and the Board of Directors are engaged in planning over \$40M of capital construction projects over the next five years.

In the works are new rodeo grounds reflecting the western heritage and culture of Medora, a shooting range, and an Event Barn which will be just southwest of the Bully Pulpit Golf Course. The Event Barn will host weddings, corporate outings with cabins constructed adjacent to the golf course. This will allow accommodations on site for those venues, and expand room capacity at a critical time.

In addition, a new hotel project is in the works, recognizing the increased demand TRPL will bring along with the expanded, year-round activities from TRMF.

None of this happens without you! Your generosity combined with private sector investment of Medora is driving our future. We are incredibly GRATEFUL, and hope you take great pride in your proprietary involvement in TRMF/Medora.

In everything we do, we work hard with management to keep in mind a couple critical themes. Foremost, we recognize how special Medora and the Badlands are, and the culture of the West which has always been present. We don't want to lose such. And, we stand forever in the shadow of Harold and Sheila Schafer, and the incredible history associated with our 26th President Theodore Roosevelt, his time in the Badlands and Medora which played such a significant role shaping his future Presidency.

Finally, I want to thank our CEO, Randy Hatzenbuhler, his dedicated management team, and all the 85 full-time TRMF employees, along with the 330 seasonal employees, and the over 800 volunteers who make TRMF/Medora so special for all of us. When you think of Char and Duey Marthaller, you think about Medora.

Their story began like many others.

"When our kids were little, we started coming out here, probably 40 years ago," Char told TRMF. "We came out with the boys, just goofing off in the park in Medora. We really enjoyed it here."

"Then when our grandkids were born, it accelerated quite a bit," Duey added.

Those family connections planted seeds for the future.

Following Duey's retirement in 2013, the duo set their minds and hearts on volunteering in Medora – and working on special projects.

"January is always 'Medora month," Char said. "That's when Duey would start working in his workshop, doing whatever we needed to build or get ready for the summer."

The fruits of that labor can be found all over Medora: from the wishing well in the Andrist Wind Garden to drip irrigation systems for Medora's flowers; from remodeled apartments above the Ferris General Store to signs and benches at the Medora Campground.

"Whatever job it is, it's the two of us together. That's the way we've always done it," explained Char.

So what keeps them coming back? "Certainly it's the people," said Duey.


The people – and the promise of the future in Medora, thanks to the hard, meaningful work of people like Duey and Char Marthaller.

Lyubchik, our Hospitality Director and my Ukrainian American husband, sat at the empty dining room table with just a laptop and a worried look on his face. He was watching the news. On the screen, a politician spoke in quick Russian about their planned takeover of his country of birth. At the same time, he was reading reports of bombs being dropped all over the country. It was February 22, 2022. Russia was invading Ukraine. The war had begun.

For the next couple of hours, we watched the invasion unfold on social media websites such as Twitter to get real-time information, though we'd never used them before. There, I saw videos of bombs being dropped on the city I had lived in for four years with my husband. Though I'm a North Dakota girl, it felt like my home was being bombed. For Lyubchik, it was.

Lyubchik and his parents, Igor and Marina, were safe in Medora with me, but the rest of the family was in Ivano-Frankivsk, Ukraine. Russia invaded Ukraine early in the morning, catching the sleeping country by surprise. As such, Lyubchik's sisters, Ira and Sofiia, were unaware they were in danger. Though we were on the other side of the world, he was the one to wake his sisters and let them know their country was at war.

Upon hearing the news, Sofiia, his younger sister, took her daughter to find safety. She lifted the door to their underground cellar and climbed down the steep ladder to sit in the dark musty hole among the pickle jars. A makeshift underground shelter. Sofiia held her daughter close as the bombs exploded only half a mile away from their Dacha (cottage). We wouldn't hear from her again for hours.

Lyubchik's older sister, Ira, was traveling for work. Her first thoughts were if her husband and two sons were safe and how she could get back to them. They needed to be together. Lyubchik guided Ira home, telling her which roads were safe, which were not, and where the bombs were falling. He helped her reach her family.

My mother and father-in-law were sleeping and unaware of the invasion. We hadn't wanted to wake them until we knew more; it felt right to give them a couple of hours of peace. A gift. However, the time had come. We woke them up in the middle of the night with the news no one ever thinks they'll hear – their daughters were temporarily safe, but their country was at war. Worry showed in Igor's usually stoic eyes, but Marina broke my heart. She wailed for her children.

After speaking with their daughters, they fell back into a fitful sleep. Eventually, so did we. The next morning, I checked my phone with fear in my heart, wondering if there was anything left of Ukraine.

Five Months Later

I don't speed. However, my right foot felt heavy on the gas pedal. Marina, of all people, encouraged this because her daughters were coming home to Medora. The excitement was palpable. We had missed the chance to meet them at the Bismarck airport but despite leaving at separate times, were catching up.

Though we couldn't see them yet, we imagined Ira and Sofiia's reactions to seeing America for the first time. How they must have smiled as they witnessed the beauty of the Badlands opening from flat ground into the stunning panorama that never fails to surprise first-time visitors. How their children must have beamed with wonder at the new country.

Despite the urge to speed, we made it home safely. Finally, I watched Marina, who only months before had cried in the middle of the night, embrace her daughters. They were safe. Tears streamed down her face—down all our faces. We laughed, hugged, and toured Medora while they tried American foods like peanut butter for the first time.

Yet, the moment was tinted with sorrow. Ira, Sofiia, and their children had come alone. Their husbands were in Ukraine, unable to leave its borders. They were prepared to fight if needed, but more prepared to be with their families. We hoped and waited for them.

18 Months Later

Ira was working, so I had the honor of picking up her husband from the airport. I got to watch his face as I drove him home, how he noted that even the trees in North Dakota were different from those in Ukraine. How he wanted to learn every English word as fast as he could, everything from sky to butte, to simple words like grass.

I drove him home to Medora to his waiting wife and sons. I saw their tears of joy as, after a year and a half they were finally reunited. It was beautiful, emotional, but bittersweet. Sofiia was alone with her daughter in the United States. Her husband still couldn't leave the country.

21 Months Later

The dining room table was filled with Ukrainian delicacies like pierogies, jelly meat, pickled tomatoes, open-face sandwiches, vodka, and wine. We were celebrating a birthday, Ukrainian style. I looked at each person there: Lyubchik and our children, Igor and Marina, Ira, her husband, and their sons, Sofiia, her daughter and, at long last, Sofiia's husband. His now four-year-old daughter's eyes twinkled with joy as she stared up at her father for the first time in almost two years. Half of her life.

Looking at them, I felt something unexpected. I felt relief. As if a weight that had been there since the beginning of the war had been lifted from my shoulders. We all looked lighter. The fear and anxiety hidden behind their eyes were gone. We'd made it.

The war in Ukraine is still happening. We still listen to the news every day to see how our friends are doing. To see how some friends are dying. To see Ukraine with its beautiful cobblestone streets and European-style buildings being destroyed. Our lives have been changed forever. Yet, Medora turned a difficult experience into something positive. Life-changing. Now, we are together. We have all come home to North Dakota.



Residents Fill Wild Horse Place After Ribbon Cutting

Families in Medora have a new place to lay their heads at night: Wild Horse Place.

On Saturday, June 24, the ribbon was officially cut on the 32-unit apartment building that now houses TRMF employees and their families, as well as Theodore Roosevelt National Park employees and other individuals wanting to call Medora home.

"This is a big day for Medora," said Randy Hatzenbuhler, TRMF President & CEO. "Our Board of Directors saw a critical need for additional permanent housing in Medora, and they encouraged us to move briskly toward the completion of Wild Horse Place."

"Medora would not be the special place that it is without great people," he continued, "and this new addition to our city allows us to recruit even more of those great people to serve the traveling public."

Cutting the ribbon at the ceremony was Greg Bavendick – who, along with his family, contributed the lead gift of \$1.5 million to see the project through to completion.

"The people here deserve it," Greg said following the ribbon cutting. "It's fulfilling for us to be able to help and make their lives a little easier."

Wild Horse Place was also made possible by Rick Berg, whose property group funded the construction. During the ceremony, he thanked the Medora City Commission for helping the project move forward, and highlighted Roers Construction for their on-time, on-budget work.

"We have almost all 32 units rented already, which is unusual," Rick said. "It feels good to know that we're meeting a clear need for this community."

One of those units is rented by Justin Morales, who is the Front Desk Operations Manager at the Badlands Motel.

"It's something I've been looking forward to since last year when I learned that Wild Horse Place was being built," Justin said. "I'm on the third floor and I get a great view of the sunset – and the fireworks every night at the *Medora Musical*."

Wild Horse Place also represents another milestone in the creation of a "campus" for the Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation. That process began in 2008 and also includes the Spirit of Work Lodge for volunteers, the Life Skills Center, and the Elkhorn Quarters. Together, these facilities bring together housing, training, education, dining, fitness, and recreation – while freeing up traffic and parking space in downtown Medora.



For more than 25 years, dedicated volunteers have been devoting their time and talent to the place they love. What started as a group of helpers has now become the heartbeat of Medora.

The initial spark of the idea came from Jean Neshiem, Medora supporter, who spoke up about improvements she felt should be made in the Medora experience for both staff and guests. As a first step, she put her money where her mouth was. She made a gift that in 1997 built what is now known as Jean's Place, an eight-plex for employee housing.

Her next step was to invite her friends to volunteer to help make guests feel more welcome. They started greeting people arriving on bus tours, then began assisting with spring cleanup and planting flowers, and it kept growing.

It didn't take long for the Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation to recognize that Jean was on to something. We hired a coordinator to build a structured program and soon volunteers were flocking to Medora to lend a hand.

Today more than 800 people from 23 states apply for the Volunteer Program, which has become critical to Medora operations. About 600 spots are available on 17 "Fun Teams" in sessions that vary in length from three days to ten days. Starting in February, retail teams help unpack and prepare merchandise. May volunteers manage spring cleaning, painting, and planting, plus ensuring all open venues are staffed before seasonal employees arrive.


The most visible volunteers are likely the Green Vesters, who can be found throughout Medora, serving food, taking tickets, ushering, handing out mini-golf clubs and handling just about anything that needs to be done. Volunteers also shuttle guests and help in retail stores, such as Teddy's Bears. In addition, there are multiple opportunities to help at Bully Pulpit Golf Course from April through September.

But that's not all. Volunteers have been key to bringing some of Medora's bigger, more labor-intensive projects to life. One is the popular Medora Children's Park, which volunteers built in a week in 2001 and refreshed in 2021. Another major project was removing the old seats at the Burning Hills Amphitheatre and installing new ones. They rebuilt the boardwalks in front of the Rough Riders Hotel and the Badlands Shooting Gallery. Those with construction expertise helped pull tree stumps and move dirt as Bully Pulpit has been improved, and others power-washed and stained the deck, clubhouse, grill shack and bathrooms.

Most importantly, Medora Fun Teams love their work, as evidenced by the smiles on their faces, the hospitality they demonstrate, and by the number who want to come back every year.

Peggy Gunther, who has led the program since 2019, is now turning the reins over to Nicole Pinner, the new Director of Volunteers. Gunther predicts that Pinner will enjoy working with these generous Medora fans as much as she has.

BLACK TIE & SPURS SETS FUNDRAISING RECORD

Shines Spotlight on Western Heritage

Every other year, Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation patrons gather for a gala event that focuses on supporting a specific major fundraising goal to advance the TRMF's mission. Last June, the Black Tie & Spurs event shone its spotlight on the Western Heritage initiative, and the evening shattered all records for past events.

With a boost supplied by a matching gift of \$250,000 from Laurel and Brent Nelson, the event raised \$591,672. "We believe in the values that Medora represents – faith, family and freedom," says Laurel, TRMF board member. "We feel the Western Heritage project will articulate those values. Here we'll tell the stories of the people who made North Dakota a great place. Their respect for family, community and country and their values of hard work, grit and perseverance, built and fed our state and our nation. If we don't tell their stories, who will?"

Rolf Sletten, TRMF board member, agrees. "I can't think of anything else that can help better capture the spirit and the feel of that Old West legacy than Western Heritage," he says. "Rodeo and the cattle industry are at the heart and soul of Medora. The more we can do to preserve and enhance that experience, the greater Medora will be."

Hailing from across the region, 250 folks joined us in town and all of our Rough Rider Members were invited to participate online. They enjoyed a delicious dinner, dashed for desserts, and raised their bidding paddles in an exciting auction of select donated items. Sletten said competition for the auction offerings was intense, and everyone had a great time. "We're very grateful for their generosity to this important addition to Medora, and we're already looking forward to the next event."



A GIFT FOR THE FUTURE

In the summer of '99, Dr. Darin and Tamara Leetun's Medora story began. That July, after taking in the Medora Musical the couple headed to Painted Canyon. It was there, under the Medora night sky, that Darin pulled out a ring to propose to Tamara. Although, because it was a dark Dakota night, Tamara thought the ring was a broach. Nevertheless, after some reassuring that it was in fact a ring and a marriage proposal, the story ended in 'I do'.

Now, the Leetun's take a trip back to the Badlands each year. Like so many of us, they find peace, beauty, and escape in Medora. They can cherish the memories they have made in our Western sanctuary and make new ones with each visit.

After over twenty years of visiting, and getting to know the people of Medora, the Leetuns decided to take a more involved role in the magic of Medora.

They decided to make a planned estate gift by naming TRMF a beneficiary of a family trust.

"You have to be purposeful," said Darin "We were in the time of our life when a lot of personal things were in order, getting closer to retirement, but didn't want to wait until retirement. We wanted to be active in the process."

One of the final pushes for the couple was a conversation with TRMF CEO and President, Randy Hatzenbuhler.

We had the opportunity to ride with Randy one day, telling him what we were thinking, and he encouraged us to at least have those discussions earlier than later. Because there have been situations...where something sudden, unexpected happens and then they can never do it," recalls Tamara.

An equally important driver as timing is the right project. When beginning the process of giving, it is important to ensure that your values align with where your money is going. For the Leetuns, that was Medora.

We wanted something that was North Dakota...but didn't want something that was one specific spot, but spoke more about North Dakota. And for us, I think it's easy to wrap it all together with Medora.

But more than being a place that speaks to our state, Medora boldly and uniquely upholds American values, one of the most important being faith. "The Medora Musical still tries to put in [faith]...that's the Harold Schafer mindset, and that's something that we believe in and can be behind. If the rest of the world is going to give up on it, Medora's still doing it, then that will be the place we played a part in keeping it alive."

Lastly, but perhaps most importantly, the Leetun's stressed the importance of legacy. Supporting the TRMF and Medora is a way to leave their mark. Gifts to Bully Pulpit Golf Course, seats at the Burning Hills Amphitheatre, connection to the foundation -- they are lasting fingerprints on the world.








IMPACT DOLLARS USED IN 2023

The Old Town Hall Theater is an unsuspecting, white-paneled building in the heart of Medora, North Dakota. However, once you pass through its doors you'll find a haven of history, arts, and entertainment.

The town hall was originally built in 1924 to serve as an activity center for Medora. In its early days, the building was often filled with movies, dances, and even boxing matches. Today, the Old Town Hall Theater hosts concerts, shows, and theater performances.

One of the most notable performances to grace the theater's stage is Million Dollar Quartet. This musical production tells the story of four legendary musicians from the golden age of rock 'n' roll. It took the stage in the fall of 2023 and was immediately met with raving reviews and overwhelming success. Throughout Million Dollar Quartet's thirty-five performances, over 7,500 guests visited the venue and took in the show. On average, each night Million Dollar Quartet played, 98% of the theater's seats were filled – soaring above projected sales goals. The show's smashing success marks the start of a new era of excitement and entertainment which will impress audiences in the next century and beyond.









Welcome Back, Bully!

Legacy Bully Pulpit Capital Campaign Restores Former Glory

Steve and Michelle Campbell of Pennsylvania are on a mission to golf 18 holes in all 50 states. Last summer they checked off their 49th state with a round at Bully Pulpit. They told KFYR-TV that it ranks third on their list of best courses, behind courses in Sedona, Arizona, and Princeville, Hawaii. "It's like putting a golf course in the middle of Yellowstone," Michelle said. "It's one of the prettiest we've done."



Bully Pulpit, Medora's 18-hole public golf course, is proud of its glowing reviews but can't take them for granted. Designed by Michael Hurdzan, a renowned golf-course architect, Bully Pulpit was listed on countless "best" lists from the time it opened 20 years ago. But those accolades have waned, so it was time to take a closer look.

One of the biggest challenges of maintaining a golf course in the Badlands is the Badlands themselves. Weather weathers everything, and flooding in low areas had also become a challenge. With the help of generous donors to its Legacy Bully Pulpit Campaign, the Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation carried out a plan to make Bully Pulpit better than ever.

Improvements include building flood protection, reconstructing the cart paths and adding GPS to the golf carts. A landscape cleanup is already underway to improve sight lines as well as significant enhancements to the irrigation system. "The GPS installation has been a huge hit with our customers," said Clarence Sitter, TRMF's Chief Operating Officer. "To be able to get the yardage from wherever they are, to see where the landmarks are, to get better directions from one hole to the next has been extremely valuable to our guests. They just rave about it."

Several of the holes have been redone, including Bully Pulpit's signature #16. Enthusiasts said that Augusta National has its "Amen Corner," while #16 is Bully Pulpit's "OMG corner." Golfers are awed by the beautiful scenery as they tee off high on a rugged bluff, watching their ball sail for what feels like forever to the fairway far below. Lastly, a big thank you to the Jim & Lynn Arthaud family for their generous gift that made the new restroom and snack shack on the back 9 a reality.

Sitter said 17,676 rounds were played at Bully Pulpit in 2023, the second-best year ever – up 12.4 percent from 2022. "We're anticipating 17,750 in 2024, and we have 30 tournaments scheduled already. We are also very excited about hosting the second Girls Golf Camp with Amy Olson, professional golfer from Fargo. We expect 150 high-school girls to take advantage of this opportunity to improve their games, earn scholarships and learn about leadership. It really fits with our mission of connecting people to Medora for life-changing experiences."

Guy Moos, President of Baker Boy in Dickinson, is a Medora supporter and Bully Pulpit fan. "If I want to take family, friends or colleagues for a special treat, I can't think of anything I enjoy more than Bully Pulpit," he said. "Taking in the stunning scenery, spotting wildlife around every corner and playing one of the best courses I've ever been on – it really is a little slice of heaven."


One Medora. One Theodore Roosevelt. Two amazing organizations!

Event Barn, cabins to fill growing demand

Who can imagine a more picturesque setting for a wedding than the beautiful Badlands? What better place for a corporate retreat than amid the peaceful stillness that allowed Theodore Roosevelt to envision his future? Where else can a family gather for a reunion that offers something to do for everyone from toddler to senior?

There is no better place than Medora, of course, but there isn't enough capacity to meet the growing demand. That gap has taken a giant step toward being filled with Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation's plan to build an Event Barn and cabin facility, just southeast of the scenic Bully Pulpit Golf Course.

Modeled after a rustic barn, the large event space will have room to handle 360 guests, kitchen facilities, bride and groom/breakout rooms, and plenty of restroom facilities. A scenic outdoor chapel space and fire pit area are on one side of the barn, while a pond and bridge on the other side will provide perfect photo opportunities or a place for quiet solitude. Multi-unit cabins for overnight stays will surround the event barn and a campsite across the road. In addition, new attractions that contain shooting ranges for rifle, shotgun, pistol and archery will complement the history of the site.

The Event Barn will be on the Custer Trail Ranch, where five major military operations once camped, including General George Armstrong Custer on his way to the Battle of Little Big Horn. Formerly known as the Eaton Ranch, it is also recognized as the first dude ranch in the United States. "The Eaton brothers, who were friends with Theodore Roosevelt, hosted a steady stream of city slickers longing to experience cowboy life," said Rolf Sletten, historian and TRMF board member. "Eventually they started charging people and turned it into a business."

The project wouldn't be possible without the support of today's successful business leaders. Bully Spirit Award winners, Mike and Peggy Bullinger, made the lead gift of \$1.5 million to jumpstart the campaign. The Bullingers believe in the future of Medora, as evidenced by their generosity toward this project as well as several others, including Little Bully Pulpit Mini-Golf Course, the Old Town Hall Theater, the Life Skills Center and Bully Pulpit.

While discussing their philosophy about philanthropy, Mike and Peggy joked lightheartedly, "You can't take it with you." But, quickly zeroing in on the question, Mike said, "Medora is where we primarily focus our sponsorships. You get to see the bricks and mortar; you see the benefit to the community and to North Dakota."

A former TRMF board member, Peggy said, "When you give money to different places, you often don't see the results; it just goes into administration. Medora spends the money wisely." Mike added, "We especially like this project because it's about bringing people together. Plus we like being involved with the people of Medora."

"It's humbling how generous Mike and Peggy are, and we certainly appreciate their trust in us," said Randy Hatzenbuhler, President and CEO of the TRMF. "Their gift will help bring this vision of a wonderful event space to fruition. It's been needed for quite some time. When the Theodore Roosevelt Presidential Library opens in 2026, we know we need more guest rooms in the community, so this will also help address that."
